

# Walking



## Enjoy

**The Wash and North Norfolk coast offer an extensive network of trails that allow you to experience seaside towns and villages, tidal marshes, sandy beaches, woodlands, and huge skies.**

Notably, The Wash and North Norfolk coast incorporate two National Trails:

1. England Coast Path – this is the newest, and longest, National Trail. The Wash and North Norfolk coast (from Gibraltar Point to Cromer) make up a 132 mile (213 km) stretch of the England Coast Path.
2. Peddars Way and Norfolk Coast Path – this is a National Trail that combines two long-distance walking trails. It provides 129.5 miles (208 km) of walking through fantastic scenery and landscape, with much of the Trail running through the Norfolk Coast Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).

## Respect

- Please use designated car parks, to avoid blocking access points
- Cooperate with people working in the area; keep away from machinery and animals that are being moved
- Gates and property should be left as you find them  
*N.B. Sometimes gates are left open to give animals access to food and water*
- Be careful not to damage historic sites/ruins
- Please refrain from entering fenced off areas, as these serve to protect vulnerable species and habitats

## Protect

- Keep to designated paths, to avoid trampling sensitive habitats
- Use gates and stiles to cross fences, hedges and walls, to prevent damage to property and important habitats
- Do not damage or remove rocks, wood, plants, or trees, as they provide shelter and food for wildlife
- Bin your litter or take it home; it spoils the beauty of the place for others and can be dangerous to wildlife
- Keep your distance from wildlife, to prevent disturbance
