The Wash and North Norfolk coast make for spectacular viewing from the sky. The area boasts several airfields dedicated to recreational flying, which means training and pleasure flying can progress unhindered.



Respect

- Do not fly closer than 150m to any person, vessel, vehicle or structure (unless necessary for taking off or landing)

Protect

- Fly at a minimum of 450m above the surface, to reduce the risk of bird collision (this is recommended by the Civil Aviation Authority, due to the area's high concentration of birds)
- Pilots are requested to avoid flying over bird reserves (these are marked on the Civil Aviation Authority charts)
