Respect people and place

- Read local updates/information and act on any advice given
- Try to use public transport, walk or cycle
- If using the car, please drive and park responsibly
- Keep to paths/routes and leave gates as you find them
- Use public waste bins or take litter home
- Try to shop locally and use local services

Protect the area and its wildlife

- Take care not to disturb wildlife
- Keep away from cordoned areas
- Ensure you don't harm, destroy or remove any wildlife/plants/rocks
- Only light fires and/or BBQs in designated places
